

ORDINANCE NO. 1624

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SHAWNEE INDIAN MISSION FUND FOR
THE CITY OF FAIRWAY, KANSAS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FAIRWAY,
KANSAS:**

Section 1. Fund Established. There is hereby established a Shawnee Indian Mission Fund that shall be used by the City to finance preservation, management, promotion, routine maintenance and day to day operations of the Shawnee Indian Mission. For the purpose of this ordinance, the word "routine maintenance" shall mean those tasks associated with daily upkeep of the Shawnee Indian Mission site, including changing light bulbs; setting the temperature of buildings for the optimum preservation of the site; mowing the grass; cleaning and stocking restroom facilities and maintaining the facilities in good working order; and other activities of similar nature or as agreed upon by the City and the Kansas State Historical Society.


Section 2. Investing. Moneys in the Shawnee Indian Mission fund shall be invested in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 10-131 and amendments thereto, with the interest earnings credited to that fund.

Section 3. Transfers. Moneys in the General Fund of the City may be transferred to the Shawnee Indian Mission Fund



Passed and approved by the Governing Body of the City of Fairway, Kansas, this 13th day of June, 2016.


